

Wedding Speech to Parents

1. Opening (Introduction)

- Start by thanking the guests for coming.
- Mention that your speech is directed to your parents and why you want to honor them.

Example:

"So tonight, as we celebrate love and family, I want to raise a glass to you, Mom and Dad. Thank you for being my anchors, my cheerleaders, and my greatest blessings. Here's to you and the incredible example of love you've set. Cheers!"
